Certificate in GENDER STUDIES

The **Certificate in Gender Studies** is designed for students seeking expertise in the cross-cultural understanding of gender and sexuality. Courses offer training in gender inequality, representations and practices of gendered bodies, gender and sexual identity, sexualities and culture, the relationships among gender, race, and class, and feminist theory in anthropology.

Requirements

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:

50B Gender and Global Health
121A Kinship and Social Organization
121D Cross-Cultural Studies of Gender
128B Race, Gender, and Science
132A Psychological Anthropology
134G HIV/AIDS in Global Context
136G Colonialism and Gender
136K The Woman and the Body
137A Reading Images Culturally
129X by petition to the Undergraduate Director, depending on the topic
Any one (1) Women's Studies course
2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis of the event. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application. For a schedule of colloquia, see <http://www.anthropology.uci.edu/>

- Colloquia summaries CANNOT be turned in after the final submission deadline
