## *Certificate in MEDICAL ANTHROPOLOGY*

The **Certificate in Medical Anthropology** is designed for students seeking expertise in the cross-cultural understanding of health and illness, as well as anthropological perspectives on science and medicine. Courses offer training in medical anthropology, science studies, representations and practices of health and illness, health and identity, and the relationships among gender, race, class, medicine and science.

### Requirements

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:

2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis of the event. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. ### **Eligibility and Submission Guidelines**

- You can only count one (1) non-anthropology course toward this certificate
- Colloquia summaries CANNOT be turned in after the final submission deadline
