Certificate in LAW AND POLICY

The **Certificate in Law and Policy** is designed for students seeking expertise in the legal, political, and cultural dimensions of citizenship, democracy, immigration, and identity in the modern world. Courses offer training in legal, political and cultural dimensions of civil society and political participation in the democratic process.

Requirements

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:
 - 121D Cross-Cultural Studies of Gender
 - 121G Political Anthropology
 - 121J Urban Anthropology
 - 125X Transnational Migration
 - 127A Law and Modernity
 - 127B Global Migrations, Anthropology, and the Law
 - 129A War and Migration
 - 129X by petition to the Undergraduate Director, depending on the topic
 - 136A Nationalism and Ethnicity in the Contemporary World
 - 136D Conflict Management in Cross-Cultural Perspective
 - 139 Prisons and Public Education
 - 161T Field Research: Asian Immigrants, and Refugees in Orange County
 - 162B Indian North America
 - 169A China and Globalization
 - Women's Studies 60B: Gender and Law
 - Criminology, Law and Society courses; by petition to the Undergrad Director
2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis of the event. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application. For a schedule of colloquia, see <http://www.anthropology.uci.edu/>

NOTE: If you're applying for multiple certificates, you only need to submit three (3) summaries *TOTAL*.

- Only UCI courses are eligible (you can't use courses from other universities)

- You can only count one (1) non-anthropology course toward this certificate
- Colloquia summaries CANNOT be turned in after the final submission deadline
