CERTIFICATE IN ECONOMY AND CULTURE

The *Certificate in Economy and Culture* is designed for students wishing to develop their expertise in the cultural and ethnographic analysis of economic processes and systems. Courses offer intensive training in non-western and non-capitalist economic practices, as well as anthropological approaches to contemporary capitalisms. The Certificate program is also intended for students interested in cross-cultural approaches to economic management and planning.

Requirements:

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:
 - 20A Peoples, Cultures, and Environmental Sustainability
 - 41A Origins of Global Interdependence
 - 50B Gender and Global Health
 - 121A Kinship and Social Organization
 - 125A Economic Anthropology
 - 125B Ecological Anthropology
 - 126A Elite Cultures
 - 125S The Anthropology of Money
 - 125X Transnational Migration
 - 128C Culture, Power, and Cyberspace
 - 129X Special Topic on Social and Economic Anthropology (by petition to the Undergraduate Advisor, depending on the topic)
2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Advisor. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application. For a schedule of colloquia, see www.anthro.uci.edu.
