### CERTIFICATE IN ECONOMY AND CULTURE

The *Certificate in Economy and Culture* is designed for students wishing to develop their expertise in the cultural and ethnographic analysis of economic processes and systems. Courses offer intensive training in non-western and non-capitalist economic practices, as well as anthropological approaches to contemporary capitalisms. The Certificate program is also intended for students interested in cross-cultural approaches to economic management and planning.

#### Requirements:

4. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:

  - 41A Origins of Global Interdependence
  - 121A Kinship and Social Organization
  - 125A Economic Anthropology
  - 125B Ecological Anthropology
  - 125M Community Change & Transnational Development
  - 126A Elite Cultures
  - 125P Economics of Traditional Societies I
  - 125Q Economics of Traditional Societies II
  - 125S The Anthropology of Money
  - 125X Transnational Migration
  - 126N Political Economy of Economic Development
  - 128C Culture, Power, and Cyberspace
  - 129X by petition to the Undergraduate Advisor, depending on the topic
5. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
6. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Advisor.
