CERTIFICATE IN GENDER STUDIES

The *Certificate in Gender Studies* is designed for students seeking expertise in the cross-cultural understanding of gender and sexuality. Courses offer training in gender inequality, representations and practices of gendered bodies, gender and sexual identity, sexualities and culture, the relationships among gender, race, and class, and feminist theory in anthropology.

Requirements:

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:

121E Women, Race and Social Movements in Latin America
132A Psychological Anthropology
133A Latinos/Latinas and Medicine

129X by petition to the Undergraduate Advisor, depending on the topic
Any one (1) Women's Studies course.
2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Advisor. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application. For a schedule of colloquia, see www.anthro.uci.edu.
