#### Requirements:

- 1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:

  - 121E Women, Race and Social Movements in Latin America
  - 132A Psychological Anthropology

  - 136G Colonialism and Gender
  - 136K The Woman and the Body
  - 137A Reading Images Culturally
  - 129X by petition to the Undergraduate Advisor, depending on the topic Any one (1) Women's Studies course.
- 2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
- 3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Advisor. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application.
