Certificate in ECONOMY AND CULTURE

The **Certificate in Economy and Culture** is designed for students wishing to develop expertise in the cultural and ethnographic analysis of economic processes and systems. Courses offer intensive training in non-western and non-capitalist economic practices, as well as anthropological approaches to contemporary capitalisms. This certificate is also intended for students interested in cross-cultural approaches to economic management and planning.

Requirements

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:
 - 20A Peoples, Cultures, and Environmental Sustainability
 - 41A Origins of Global Interdependence
 - 121A Kinship and Social Organization
 - 125A Economic Anthropology
 - 125B Ecological Anthropology
 - 125M Community Change & Transnational Development
 - 126A Elite Cultures
 - 125P Economics of Traditional Societies I
 - 125Q Economics of Traditional Societies II
 - 125S The Anthropology of Money
 - 125X Transnational Migration
 - 126N Political Economy of Economic Development
 - 128C Culture, Power, and Cyberspace
 - 139 Anthropology of Development
 - 129X by petition to the Undergraduate Director, depending on the topic
2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a one page report and/or analysis of the event. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application. For a schedule of colloquia, see <http://www.anthropology.uci.edu/>

- Colloquia summaries CANNOT be turned in after the final submission deadline
