## *Certificate in ECONOMY AND CULTURE*

The **Certificate in Economy and Culture** is designed for students wishing to develop expertise in the cultural and ethnographic analysis of economic processes and systems. Courses offer intensive training in non-western and non-capitalist economic practices, as well as anthropological approaches to contemporary capitalisms. This certificate is also intended for students interested in cross-cultural approaches to economic management and planning.

All certificates will be awarded at a special reception toward the end of Spring quarter.

### Requirements

1. Complete (or expect to complete) **three** (3) of the following courses by graduation. Additional courses may also count toward this certificate.

2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the **three** (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend **three** (3) Anthropology Colloquia, and write a report and/or analysis of the event. These should be **between 300-500 words**. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia **BEFORE** you submit your certificate application.
