## *Certificate in GLOBAL STUDIES*

**The Certificate in Global Studies** is designed for students wishing to develop expertise in cultural, political, and economic phenomena that cross or transcend national boundaries. Courses offer intensive training in the anthropological analysis of international issues, such as migrations and diasporas, environment and development, flows of money and commodities, social movements, transnational religious movements, and ethnic, national, and other forms of political conflict.

All certificates will be awarded at a special reception toward the end of Spring quarter.

1. Complete (or expect to complete) **three (3)** of the following courses by graduation. Additional courses may also count toward this certificate.
