All certificates will be awarded at a special reception toward the end of Spring quarter.

1. Complete (or expect to complete) **three** (3) of the following courses by graduation. Additional courses may also count toward this certificate.

- 3. Attend **three** (3) Anthropology Colloquia, and write a report and/or analysis of the event. These should be **between 300-500 words**. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia BEFORE you submit your certificate application.
