2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the **three (3)** courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program

Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Director. It is your responsibility to plan ahead and attend colloquia **BEFORE** you submit your certificate application.
